

This auction is for a Austin Healey Pilgrim 3000 kit car that has undergone the basic build but needs completing.

The chassis is made up, and a Ford 2000 Sierra has been used as the donor car. The engine is an OHC 2 litre Ford, which has been rebuilt. The gear box is in place along with the back axle, but a new propshaft needs to be fabricated. The wheel hubs, steering rack, brakes and suspension elements have all been fitted. The pedal box, wiring loom, steering column etc. from the donor car are all included. There are Sierra alloys (Cosworth style) but they will need refurbishing, I am not sure if they are appropriate for the build but are included. The body tub is as supplied from the factory, it still has the release wax from the moulding. The doors/boot lid/bonnet and hinges are all present, as they left the Pilgrim factory. This kit provides the ideal opportunity to build a stunning Healey 3000 replica with some of the difficult jobs already done. I took this in a part exchange deal but no longer have the time available to complete it. The kit has no identity and will need to be registered through the DVLA when finished.
